

Insurance

Joppenhof International Department is a part of Joppenhof. The other partner is the Dutch department. Together they form one of the 21 schools of MosaLira, the overall board.

Here we will give some explanation about the insurance during school hours:

- Every person in The Netherlands has a medical insurance. All the medical cost will be declared on this personal insurance. Therefore, if a child has an accident during school hours and a doctor is needed or a child needs to go to the hospital, the costs will be declared on this medical insurance.
- Every person in The Netherlands has an WA insurance. It's a personal insurance. Accidents with damage on clothes, glasses, bags etc. will be declared on this insurance. So when student "A" harms the glasses of student "B", the insurance of student "A" should pay for the damage of student "B". Student "B" (his parents insurance) should point the insurance as being responsible for the damage.
- The school is responsible in cases of negligence from their side. When teachers do not control children during playtime or the school expose children to dangerous situations on purpose and parents can prove that the school didn't take the responsibility they should have taken, then school has to deal with the cost of the case.
- The school is responsible for the children during the school hours. After school parents are responsible. In some cases (school camp, school trips etc.) the school is responsible until the children are handed over to the parents.
