School Fee Regulations

School Year 2010-2011

The UWC Maastricht Primary requests a school fee. This fee is not voluntary. The purpose of this fee is to pay for a great number of facilities, which the Dutch government either does not compensate for at all or, we feel, does not compensate sufficiently. All these facilities are necessary to guarantee the quality of the curriculum, but also to give your child happy memories of his/her school days. We would like to mention here, for instance, reducing the group size with additional teachers, additional language teaching (ESL, DAL), specialist teachers for subjects (Music, Health & Wellness, ICT) extra learning support, attending to special needs, organising school concerts and cultural events, a department secretary and also purchasing extra materials and learning aids.

We depend on your support and financial contributions in order to create a school atmosphere, which does justice to our wish to give your child a genuinely happy school time.

We therefore ask you to sign the attached agreement form and accept the terms and conditions stated below:

School Fee Regulations:

1.
By signing the school fee agreement, the signatory undertakes to pay school fees for every child registered (on the agreement form) in the current school year. Parents/guardians may apply to their employer with a request to bear the amount due. The school fee will be fixed by the School Board once a year. This agreement is entered into for the duration of one year unless terminated by any of the parties in writing received by the other before the end of the school year.

2.
The school fee refers to the whole United World College Maastricht Primary School, to commence on the first day of school up to and including the last day of the school year thereafter. In the case of registering a pupil before the 16th day of the month, the full monthly amount is due. In the case of registering a pupil after the 15th day of the month, half the monthly amount will be due. Parents/guardians have the choice of paying the school fees directly or by instalments as stated on the invoice (monthly, five instalments, two instalments or the full amount)

3.
The school fee agreement shall be signed and returned to the school within ten working days of receiving it. The school fee is payable within the time specified on the invoice.
4.
We regret, it is not possible to pay the school fee in cash at the office.
5.
Payment obligation is applicable in so far as the signatory as mentioned in paragraph 1 has, by entering into this agreement, declared his/her wish to claim to the facilities provided for herein. In case of non-payment (within 30 days of the invoice date), the School Board and the UWC Maastricht Management claim the right, if in so far as a payment obligation has arisen from signing this agreement, to exclude the pupil from the extra facilities paid from the school fee and place the pupil in the Joppenhof Dutch Department, Kelvinstraat 3, Maastricht.
6.
If the school fees of the previous year have not been settled in full, your child(ren) will not be allowed to enrol for the upcoming school year until that debt is paid in full.
